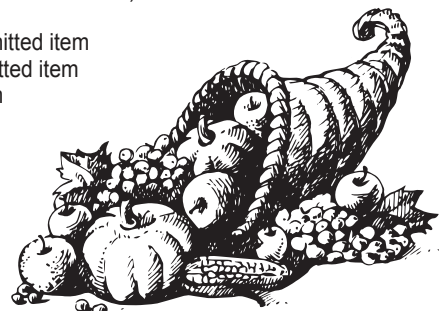

All exhibit varieties must be grown by the exhibitor. Entries should be washed, and outer leaves removed. Tops and roots on root vegetables **trimmed to two inches**. Stems on tomatoes should be left intact. Judged on uniformity, size, colour, form, free form blemishes, condition and quality. **Be aware of the number requirements in each category.**
