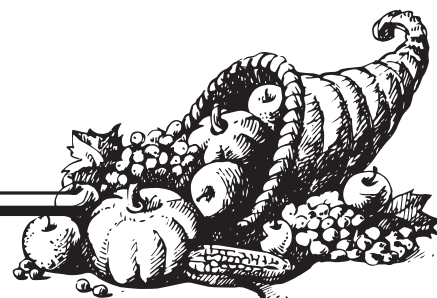

# ROSSLAND FALL FAIR

## RULES & REGULATIONS

---



### *Please Read Carefully!*

The Rossland Fall Fair is operated for the purpose of promoting and displaying the work of those interested in agriculture, domestic science and hand crafts. The Fair itself gives everyone in our community the opportunity to show, test and display their achievements for the enjoyment of all.

You are invited to enter into the spirit of neighbourly competition that characterizes the Rossland Fall Fair and to become a part of this community event.

***Please read the following rules and regulations carefully.***

1. Competition in the Rossland Fall Fair is open to any amateur competitor.

2. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as they like but they are limited to one entry per class for judging.

3. Exhibitors should note the class requirements and standards for judging when preparing their exhibits. **Please enter the exact number as specified in each category.**

4. Exhibits will be accepted at the arena on Friday, September 7, 2018 between the hours of 12:00 noon and 7:00 p.m.

5. To pre-register, mail your completed registration form with appropriate entry fees to the following address:

6. Entry fees are \$0.50 per exhibit unless otherwise noted and are non-refundable in the event of withdrawal.

7. Judging of exhibits will take place on Saturday, September 8, 2018 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Members of the public will not be admitted while judging is underway.

8. Where fewer than five exhibits in a class are presented, prizes are awarded at the discretion of the judging committee. All judging decisions are final.

9. While every precaution will be taken to protect the exhibits, the Rossland Fall Fair cannot accept responsibility in the event of theft, loss or damage. Neither can the Rossland Fall Fair accept responsibility for injury to any exhibitor or spectator.

10 Prizes are as follows unless otherwise stated:

**1st Prize : \$ 3.00**  
**2nd Prize : \$ 2.00**  
**3rd Prize : \$ 1.00**

11. Prizes may be claimed Saturday, September 8, 2018 at the arena between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. **Unclaimed prize money becomes the property of the Rossland Fall Fair.**

12. No exhibit is to be removed from the arena before 5:00 p.m. Saturday, September 8, 2018. **Unclaimed exhibits become the property of the Rossland Fall Fair to dispose of as appropriate.**

13. Exhibits must be made, grown or produced by the exhibitor. Prize winning exhibits from previous Rossland Fall Fairs are ineligible. The Rossland Fall Fair Directors reserve the right to refuse any exhibit.

**14. Exhibits in Canning & Preserving, or Jams & Jellies sections must be current year or one year previous.**

**PLEASE NOTE: THE FALL FAIR IS A ONE DAY EVENT.**
