Exhibitors: Bring entries for submission **Friday, September 8th from 12:00PM to 7:00PM**

Doors open to public: Saturday, September 9th at 12:00PM

The Rossland Fall Fair invites you to enter into the spirit of neighbourly competition with an opportunity to showcase your handwork in growing, making, and baking. Please review the following rules and regulations carefully.

1. Competition in the Rossland Fall Fair is open to any amateur competitor.
2. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as they like, however, they are limited to one entry PER class for judging.
3. Exhibitors should note the requirements and standards for each category when preparing their entries. See Entry List (yellow brochure) for information.
4. To pre-register, email completed forms to rosslandbc.fallfair@gmail.com
5. Entry fees are \$0.50 per entry and are non-refundable in the event of withdrawal.
6. Judging of the exhibits will take place on Saturday, September 9, 2023, from 8:00AM to 10:00AM. Members of the public will not be admitted while judging is underway.
7. While every precaution will be taken to protect entries, the Rossland Fall Fair cannot accept responsibility in the event of theft, loss, or damage. The Rossland Fall Fair does not accept responsibility for the injury to any exhibitor or spectator.
8. Prizes are as follows:
 - 1st Prize: \$3.00
 - 2nd Prize: \$2.00
 - 3rd Prize: \$1.00
9. Prizes are to be claimed Saturday, September 9th, 2023, at the Rossland arena between the hours of **5:00PM and 6:00PM**. Unclaimed prize money becomes property of the Rossland Fall Fair.
10. No entries are to be removed from the arena **before 5:00PM** Saturday, September 9th, 2023. Unclaimed entries become property of the Rossland Fall Fair to dispose of as appropriate.
11. Entries must be made, grown, or produced by the exhibitor. Prize winning entries from previous Rossland Fall Fairs are ineligible. The Rossland Fall Fair has the right to refuse any entry.
