Children under the age of 16 at the time of the Rossland Fall Fair are eligible to exhibit their work. No pre-made kits please.

Art Work: Entries must have been completed within the past 12 months, be mounted to a size not greater than 15"x18" and be the work of the exhibitor. Entries will be judged on age-appropriate presentation, craftsmanship and creativity. Size restrictions for Lego 60 x 60cm.

Baking: Entries must be displayed on white paper/plastic plates and wrapped in clear plastic.

Section 200 - Flowers

Flowers and plants must have been grown by the exhibitor. Cut flower must be presented in **clear (uncoloured) glass** containers. Entries will be judged on the basis of presentation and quality of plant material. **Be aware of the number requirements in each category.**

C - Decorative Arrangements

Arrangements of fresh cut, dried, weathered or treated material in a container. No artificial flowers or foliage. Maximum space for exhibit is 24" wide, 20" deep. Backdrop material may be added. Judged on artistic merit and quality of plant material.

- 223 Memories of Yesteryear: Design incorporating an item of 50+ years ago
- 224 Harvest Plenty: Buffet table arrangement that may include fruits & vegetables in addition to floral materials.

Section 300 - Fruits & Vegetables

Entries must be displayed on white paper/plastic plates

A - Vegetables

All varieties must be grown by the exhibitor. Entries should be washed, and outer leaves removed. Tops and roots on root vegetables **trimmed to two inches**. Stems on tomatoes should be left intact. Judged on uniformity, size, colour, form, free from blemishes, condition and quality. **Be aware of the number requirements in each category.**

B - Fruit

All entries must be grown by the exhibitor. **Stems must be left intact**. Judged on uniformity of size, colour, form, free from blemishes, condition and quality. **Be aware of the number requirements in each category.**

- 352 Zucchini vehicle must be made of a single zucchini. Vehicle must be less than 25cm (10 in) in width including wheels and decorations (to fit on track). At least one axle must pass through the zucchini (e.g. dowel with spinning wheels is acceptable, a zucchini strapped to a skateboard or a toy is not). Vehicle must be gravity-powered. **Will be judged on creativity and speed.**

Entries must be displayed on white paper/plastic plates and wrapped in clear plastic. Entries must not be made with mixes. Recipes optional. Judged on crust, size, crumb-texture, moisture, colour, lightness, flavour and odour.
